Reason for Visit			
Horse had his shoes pulled 10 days ago and had a difficult transition to barefoot. History as a three day event horse, has competed throughout life, but increasing lower limb/foot lameness issues.			
Client Comments			
Horse was put into front boots and pads when shoes were pulled. Produced severe soreness behind, with horse stepping high with the back legs. He was unwilling to move, posture shifted to the forehand with rear feet well forward. Resting alternate rear legs. Boots were removed from front, and immediate improvement noted.			
Practitioner Observations			
Horse is stepping wide behind, tail is held to the right. Heat detected in feet			
Rest From Work			
48 hours			
Resume Normal Work			
Dependent on rehab to barefoot.			
Exercises			
Neck stretches both sides, butt tucks.			
Other Recommendations			
Continue to work closely with trimmer to rehab the feet. If boots are deemed appropriate to protect the feet, use 4 boots with even padding to maintain a level plane of motion.
